

Dear Parents,

Exciting things are in store for your child(ren) in SuperChurch in the coming months and we'd like to share them with you.

First of all, after 9 years of faithful service, Miss Michele has stepped down from SuperChurch Leadership. However, she won't be going too far....you'll see her on the Adult worship team on Sunday mornings. She's assured the kids that she'll be around, "keeping tabs" on them and may even pop into SuperChurch now and then. Also, we do plan to tap into her giftings for special events such as the Halloween outreach and Veteran's Day Services. We very much appreciate everything she has brought to this ministry and wish her the best.



There are a few practical things that are important for you to know.

- Name change: Pastor Bob and Rachelle would like to have a "Life" theme throughout the church, so our ministry name will now be "Life Kids". The specific ministry will probably follow the "Life Kids" title, ie: Life Kids SuperChurch, Life Kids Camp, etc.
- Registration: For safety, communication and general purposes, we need to get some base information for each child. Please fill out and return the enclosed registration cards as soon as possible.
- Dismissal protocol: On Sundays, unless you give us specific direction to hold your child, we will release the children when the adult service dismisses or very shortly thereafter. When we are at activities and events other than the church, we'll release the children directly to you, the parent, or a designated caregiver.
- Out of consideration for others, safety for the kids, and **especially** for the safety of our elderly, we instruct the children, on a regular basis, to **not** run inside the church. Thank you for your support in helping us teach these kids this important courtesy.
- Communication venues: Our primary mode of communication will continue to be email. If the children have an email address, we will send to both parent and child. Please check your email regularly so you don't miss important information. The church website (newlifewc.org) will also be kept up to date with information and an event calendar.

Looking ahead to where God wants us to take these kids.

- **Vision:** The Life Kids Vision is to raise up children that know how to live life with Christ. Key factors in achieving this include: 1) Building a strong foundation in the fundamental truths of the Bible; 2) Developing a desire and passion for spending time with God in Worship; 3) Instilling a heart within the children for sharing Jesus with others and 4) Equipping the children for ministry both inside and outside the church.
- **Faith Case:** We are SO excited to roll out "**Faith Case - Investigating the Truth**" on Sunday, February 12!! As Mr. Jon leads us on a search and investigation of a different faith fact each week, we will learn what we believe and why we believe it. Each week your child will come home with a case summary sheet that includes a top secret code that allows them to receive updates from "The Commissioner" on FaithCase.com. The bonus is that you, as parents, can follow along with what they are learning!!
- Ministry opportunities: Children will continue to have opportunities for ministry in SuperChurch, and at the annual Halloween and Veteran's Day events. We also plan to bring back the Nursing Home and *Party in the Park* Outreach events that we've done in the past. More. info on that later.
